### HIGHLIGHTS:

- Primary bone tumours are heterogeneous ranging from benign to malignant categories. The histopathological diagnosis of bone tumours can be challenging with morphological overlap between reactive/benign/malignant entities, particularly on a biopsy sample, with inherent sampling bias due to tumour heterogeneity. This requires additional ancillary diagnostic techniques to study specific genetic alterations which not only helps in arriving at a definite diagnosis but also enables the delivery of targeted therapies. The final diagnosis, however, relies on a comprehensive clinicopathological and radiological correlation best achieved as a multidisciplinary team.
- The objective of this workshop is to update pathologists and oncologists on the recent developments in the diagnosis of bone tumours and the various diagnostic challenges encountered in the molecular era. Following guest lectures by renowned national and international faculty, an array of interesting cases will be presented and discussed with live slide viewing as well.
